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Step Four: Solutions & Systems Roadmapping

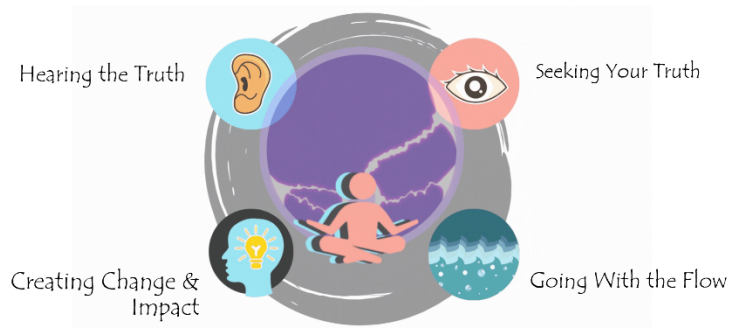
Getting clear on the plan for future automation, integrations, and partnerships – *this is all us*

Most of our recommendations are low and no-cost solutions that you can implement in baby steps!

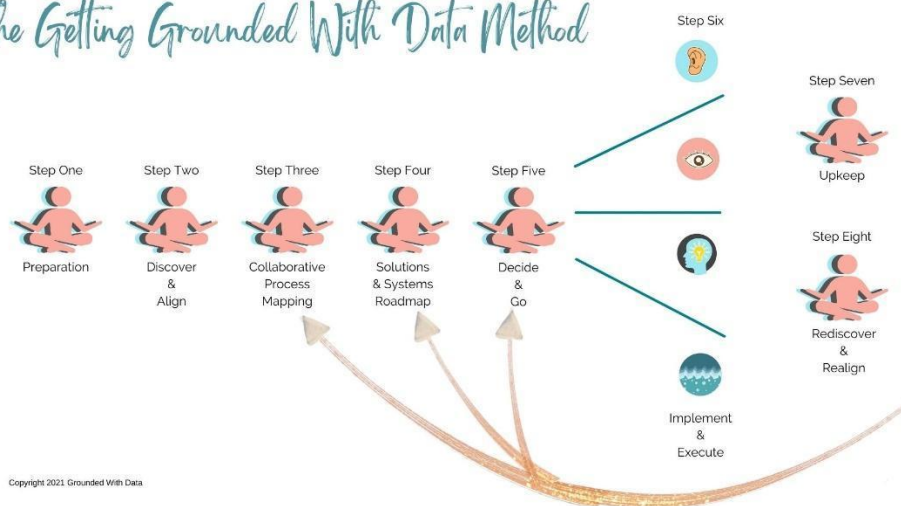
The Grounding Points
